



TORQUE CHART

Tighten all screws, bolts, and nuts to their specified torque values. Refer to the Service Manual for the torque values of the removed parts.


INSTALLATION A CAUTION

• To prevent burns, allow the engine, exhaust system, radiator, etc., to cool before installing the accessory.


NOTE:

- Disconnect the negative (-) cable from the battery before installing this accessory.
- The memories of the clock will be erased when you disconnect the battery. Reset the memories after reconnecting the battery.
- Reinstall the removed parts on the motorcycle and make sure that the wires and harnesses are not pinched.
- 1. Open the left saddlebag lid as shown.
 - Repeat on the right side.




2. Remove the left side cover as shown, and disconnect the negative (-) cable of the battery.




3. Remove the right side cover in the same manner as the left side.

Remove the seat as shown.




5. Remove the right and left passenger grip as shown.




6. Remove the fuses as shown.




- 7. Remove the left pillion step holder cover as shown.
 - Repeat on the right side.




- 8. Open the rear trunk lid as shown.
 - Refer to the Owner's Manual and using an emergency trunk cable to open the rear trunk lid.





 - Perform this step on GL1800DA only.















- 44. Install the saddlebag rear center cowl, rear fender, right and left passenger grip in the reverse order of removal.




