


TORQUE CHART

Tighten all screws, bolts, and nuts to their specified torque values. Refer to the Service Manual for the torque values of the removed parts.



INSTALLATION


1. Remove the left rearview mirror as shown. <Left side>




2. Remove the parts as shown.




3. Install the left lever pivot bolt as shown.




4. Remove the bolt as shown.




5. Install the left knuckle guard as shown.




6. Loosely install the left guard stay and the left rearview mirror as shown.




7. Install the left knuckle guard as shown.




- 8. Tighten the bolts to the specifications in the torque chart.
 - Tighten the upper bolt first, then tighten the lower bolt.




9. Tighten all loosely installed hardware to the specifications in the torque chart.




10. Move the throttle cables as shown. <**Right side**>



11. Remove the parts as shown.



- 12. Install the right knuckle guard as shown.
 - First install the right lever pivot bolt.



13. Reposition the throttle cables and tighten the nuts securely.
